Winter NSWCA Board Meeting
Noon Lunch @ Boarders Inn in Grand Island/Meeting 1:00 PM

President Derry Trampe called the meeting to order @ 12:35 PM.

Secretary's Report:

Read Minutes for October 12, 2014 Fall NSWCA Board Meeting, held at York's Chance's R Restaurant.

Todd Porter Secretary; Minutes Approved: Mattox moved to accept; Max seconded.

Treasurer's Report:

Tanner Thiem Treasurer, was absent. Derry commented about Treasury report that Tanner sent us. We are now AHEAD financially, with a tentative balance of \$678.70. Checks pending Include: Riverside Inn & Suites - \$250 for Winter Board meeting meal; Huskermat - \$500; Misko Sports - \$1,808.30; & SR Scholarships - \$1,000 to the 4 SRs honored last summer – they need to give Porter a transcript from 1st Semester of college.

Mattox motioned to accept Treasurer's report; Nelson seconded.

OLD BUSINESS:

1. Memberships & Sponsors: Derry stated that he hoped we would NOT have to raise the \$ to the wrestlers for the 2015 All-Star Dual (currently \$200; suggested possibly raising to \$250) We will wait to see how coaches membership \$ ends up; hopefully will be able to cover the costs without raising costs to kids.

2. Academic All-State Nominations: Tyler Hodges will collect these, assisted by Jason Konicek of Norfolk Catholic

3. Special Awards Nominations: Derry encouraged us to seek out new nominees from the State Wrestling Meet as contributors, perhaps workers who have worked tables at State Meet for many years.

4. All Star Dual Coaches: Discussed having a total of 12 Coaches – 6 per team, as we did last year. 7 are returning for their 2nd dual (2 year service). We discussed and selected more nominees to ask to coach in 2015: Nominations to Coach; will ask in order of listing:

5. Top 10 State Team Certificates from last year: Froscheiser stated he has the certificates, and will send them out shortly.

6. All Star Dual Announcer: Jim Garfield accepted for 2015. He will be paid \$50 to announce – he was extremely honored to be selected by the NSWCA.

7. NSWCA Website update: Denson discussed potential changes, saying it would cost about \$1,000 to successfully upgrade the website, with an outside website developer. The idea is to make it more user friendly., for viewers and Board members alike. Discussion of NSWCA paying \$500, and Denson paying \$500.

Motion to authorize Denson to continue working on this. Motioned by Mattox, seconded by Hodges. Passed unanimously.

1. Fundraising for All Star Dual: Derry mentioned doing Raffle again this year.

2. Virginia Nationals: Porter stated he will again spearhead the NSWCA Nebraska team to Virginia Beach in March 2015. He will send out info and collect sign ups. More discussion at March meeting – Porter will have more concrete info then.

3. Board Members – 2014-15 approval; discussed Kyle Bluhm (Elkhorn) – hasn’t been to many meetings – discussed and decided to let him finish his term out, and will encourage him to attend next meeting.

4. Nominations and selections for 2015 Hall of Fame: Discussion and selection followed, until these individuals were selected. They will be contacted by Secretary Porter concerning their selection to the HOF.
